StrivePartnership launched in **Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky** to improve educational outcomes

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Initial success leads to Living Cities investment to **codify learning** as well as build and test a framework for action in four communities

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StriveTogether works with a network of communities to develop theory of action to focus on **quality collective impact**

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StriveTogether becomes an **independent 501c(3) organization**

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A third-party evaluation of the **theory of action** validates StriveTogether's approach

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StrivePartnership starts using data to apply **continuous improvement** principles with support from industry leaders

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Stanford Social Innovation Review publishes seminal article on **collective impact** highlighting StrivePartnership

StriveTogether launches the Cradle to Career Network with convenings of communities across the country

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First network community designated a **Proof Point** with evidence of **shifts in systems and improvement** across most cradle-to-career outcomes

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StriveTogether develops a strategic plan focusing on cross-sector systems change and economic mobility to eliminate racial, ethnic, and economic disparities in communities

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StriveTogether formalizes its position on racial and ethnic equity
